- The homework should be handwritten in A4-sized papers, and in a neat tidy way, for TAs to read and grade.
- Plagiarism is strictly prohibited. No cheating is allowed.
 - Confirmation of plagiarism or cheating will directly fail you in this course.
 The consequence is not negotiable.
- Discussion is generally encouraged, but not for the HW problems.
 - You need to do the HW problems on your own.
 - Likewise, you may not share your homework answers with others.

Homework Turn-in
